Why does diabetes matter?


- Diabetes is one of the leading causes of death
- Diabetics are at 2-4 times greater risk for heart attacks and strokes
- Uncontrolled diabetes often comes with signs and symptoms (Figure 1)
- Some patients with diabetes don't know they have it because they don't appear to be overweight, so many do not get screeded for Type 2 diabetes mellitus (T2DM)

What is Type 2 diabetes?

Type 2 diabetes, the most common type of diabetes, cause high blood sugar due to the reduced production of insulin and insulin resistance. Insulin resistance is when glucose in the blood cannot enter the cells as easily because the cells do bot respond to insulin properly

Prevention and awareness

Prolonged high blood sugar due to uncontrolled diabetes can lead to long-term complications (Figure 2). T2DM can be managed through diet, medication, and physical activity. Monitor blood sugar with regular check-ups.
